

Leaders for the Future

Leaders for the Future is a nationally recognised course for teachers with leadership potential in the early stages of their career.

Five inspiring modules focus on developing leadership skills, knowledge and mind sets which can be used immediately to increase teacher's impact beyond the classroom through influencing others and working on wider projects. All modules are delivered by our own highly specialised and accredited leaders.

Course Modules

1. Leading Yourself

Wednesday 20th September 2017 : 4 - 6 pm

Before you are able to lead and manage others, you need to know and manage yourself effectively. This means developing emotional intelligence; understanding your own personality and seeking to understand others, considering how you communicate and how you are perceived by others.

2. Leading for Impact

Wednesday 4th October 2017 : 4 - 6 pm

This module explores the component parts of 'vision', how to explain a personal vision and consider its impact upon the individual, the team and the school. Delegates start to explore the key elements of building an effective team and begin to evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of particular teams in delivering successful outcomes.

An examination of the aspects of project management will provide a structure through which a project or plan can be achieved.

3. Leading and Influencing Others

Wednesday 18th October 2017 : 4 - 6 pm

Teachers in the early stages of their careers are often given projects and whole-school initiatives to lead on where they have no formal authority and therefore need to access a wide range of interpersonal skills and influencing styles in order to achieve success. In this module delegates take a rationale and analytical approach to understanding the needs and agendas of those around them.

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4. Leading Yourself for the Long Term

Wednesday 8th November 2017 : 4 - 6 pm

Teaching requires both long-term and short-term strategies to ensure that teachers stay motivated, healthy and on top of their responsibilities. This module aims to help to think about how they can be effective now in their current role and how they can ensure they make the best personal choices about how they want to develop in the future.

5. Leading Through Coaching and Mentoring

Wednesday 22nd November : 4 - 6 pm

This session explores the different approaches that should be considered when supporting a colleague or leading a team. The session helps delegates to identify when best to use these approaches, strategies to use and the potential risks.
